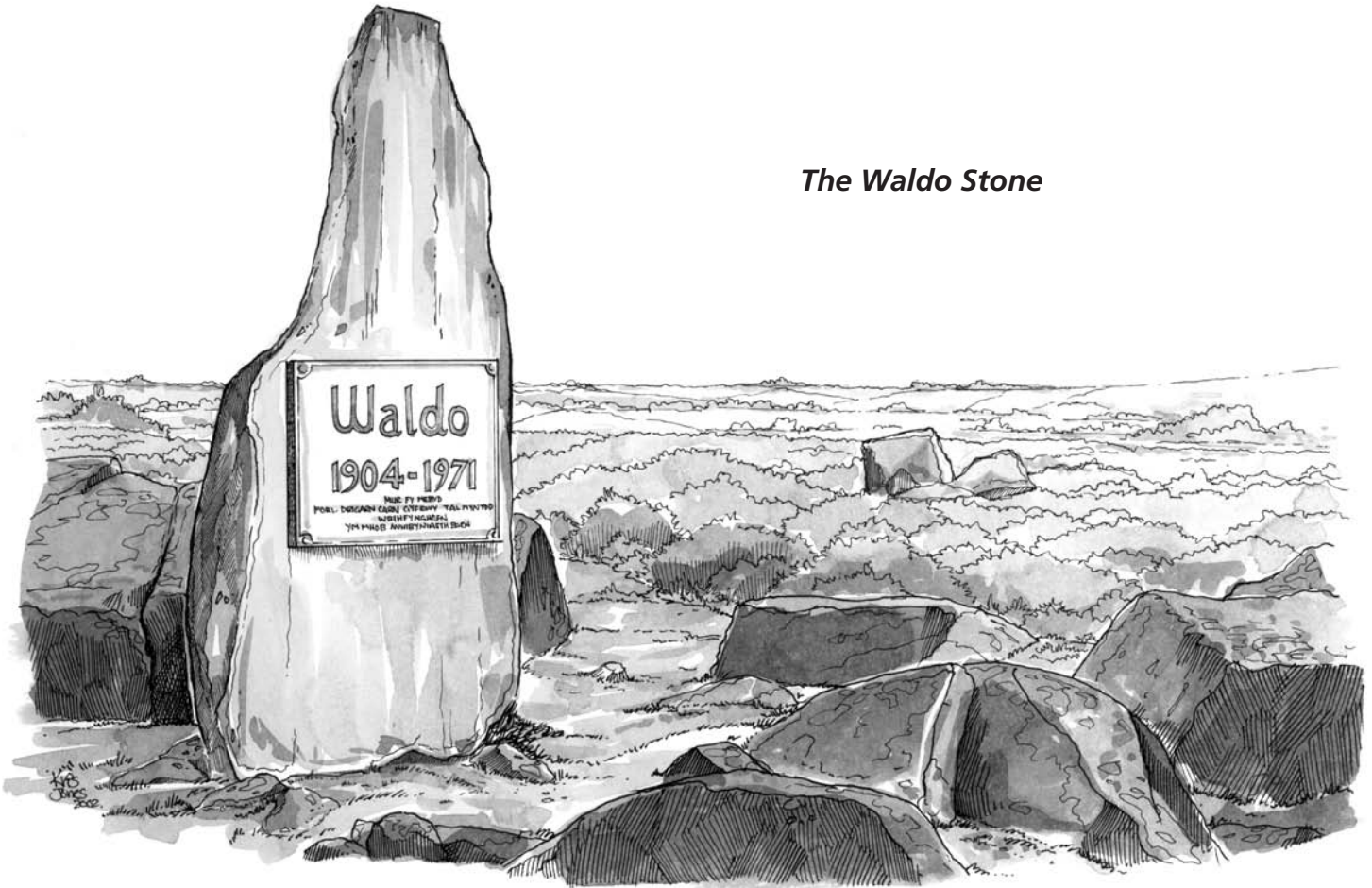




## *The Waldo Stone*



*track forks. Take the next track on the left leading down into the valley, follow this to the road. Either follow the road round to the left to return to Mynachlog-ddu, or carry straight on to cross Gors Fawr with its standing stones and stone circle. Go through the kissing gate to get back onto the road. Turn left and follow the road back into Mynachlog-ddu.*

### **Rosebush Circular Walk**

Beginning at Rosebush with its disused railway and quarries this walk climbs to the top of Foel Cwm Cerwyn, offering superlative views.

*The route is 5m/8km, 2-2.5 hrs. The surface is good forest road and upland trackway, crossing some marshy ground. Ascents, descents 266mtrs/864ft. This route has 4 gates and three stiles.*

**ROSEBUSH R** Buses 344, 345  
Slates from the quarries of Rosebush were used to roof the Houses of Parliament. The village stands below the summit of Foel Cwm Cerwyn.

*Beginning from the old post office at Rosebush walk past the terrace of cottages and follow the track past the disused quarry buildings and*

*old workings. Go through the gate and follow the track up into the forest. As the track emerges from the trees take the waymarked bridleway on the left. Follow this path up to the ridge.*

*Go through the gate in the fence and turn right, take care here as the ground is marshy. Follow the fence line as it climbs for about 0.5mile/1km. To continue on the circular walk, turn right over the stile and follow the track up to Foel Cwm Cerwyn. It is said that on a clear day you can see Ireland from here, the view is worth the climb.*

ridge connecting Carn Sian and Foel Cwm Cerwyn. This track takes in a third peak, Foel Feddau.

### Connecting Route

The connecting route is 1.6m/ 2.6km, 1hr on similar surfaces to the circular walks described above. Ascents: 127mtrs/ 396ft, descents: 17mtrs/55ft.

*From the Mynachlog-ddu circular walk take the track past*

*The track runs over the peak and down the mountain to the gate at the corner of the forestry. Go through the gate and follow the track along the edge of the forest being careful to avoid marshy ground.*

*As the track emerges into farmland a stile on the left leads, via fields and a farmyard, back to the main road. Turn right to return to the old post office.*

To make a longer walk these two circular routes can be connected by a walk along the

*Carn Bica as described above. Follow the staked path into the saddle between Carn Sian and Mynydd Bach. Take the track leading up to Foel Feddau leaving the crags at Cerrigmarchogion on your left.*

*From here follow the ridge up to the old forestry fence. Join the Rosebush circular walk at the stile. Turn left over the stile for Foel Cwm Cerwyn or continue down the fence line for a slower descent into Rosebush.*
